Rolling Thunder IL 1 Accomplishments During 2012

- 1. We initiated a Bowe Bergdahl billboard campaign. Our billboard was the first in the nation. It has since gained national attention. Our fifth billboard is presently up in Springfield, IL. We have freely shared our billboard graphics with Rolling Thunder Chapters across the country.
- 2. Activities we funded during 2012 were:
 - a. A \$24,000 Recumbent Bathing System for LaSalle Veterans Home. The system was installed several months ago and reports are that the staff and patients love it.
 - b. We donated \$6,000 to the Nicholas Larsen Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans in Wheaton.
 - c. We donated \$2,000 to The Ride Home, an organization at the civil war POW camp in Andersonville, GA and home of the National Prisoner of War Museum.
 - d. We donated to \$2,000 to Task Force Omega. Task Force Omega keeps our POW Bowe Bergdahl and the POW/MIA mission in the eyes and ears of the Washington, DC politicians. Task Force Omega is an organization dedicated to the full accounting and return of all prisoners of war and those missing in action.
 - e. We donated \$1,500 to the Manteno State Veterans Home in Manteno, IL.
- 3. We successfully applied for a grant from a benefactor who prefers to remain anonymous. Our efforts were rewarded with a grant of \$69,000 to benefit the resident veterans at the LaSalle Veterans Home, LaSalle, IL. (This is in addition to the \$24,000 bathing system).
- 4. We carried over the billboard graphics into a bumper sticker campaign that has distributed thousands of POW Bowe Bergdahl bumper stickers
- 5. We performed the Remembrance Table Ceremony on four occasions:
 - a. The Cantigny Vet Fest
 - b. The Big Thunder Run
 - c. The Wheaton VFW
 - d. The Glendale Heights VFW
- 6. Our present structure allows 97½ cents from every fundraising dollar to be spent on the POW/MIA issue and assisting local veterans.
- 7. And, just in case you weren't counting, that is \$104,500 on local veterans and the POW/MIA issue.

Additionally, for those new to Rolling Thunder, we are not a motorcycle club. To join Rolling Thunder one does not need a motorcycle, you do not have to be a veteran, you can be of either gender and any age. Quite a few of our members are not veterans. Some of my favorite people in Rolling Thunder wear a simple patch that reads: "I wasn't there but I still care." All you need is a willingness to work on the POW/MIA cause.
